

CHILD NUTRITION SERVICES INFORMATION

Akron Public Schools serve nutritious meals every school day for their student population. All meals served must meet nutrition standards established by the U.S. Department of Agriculture. Akron Public Schools' Child Nutrition Services Department is pleased to announce the following with regards to its meal programs for 2011-2012:

1) Students at all K-5 and K-6 elementary school buildings, Innes CLC, Akron Opportunity Center and Bridges Learning Center will receive breakfast and lunch meals, and snack where available, at no cost.

2) Students in Akron Middle/High Schools, including Miller-South and NIHF-STEM, that are directly certified for "Free" meals through the receipt of SNAP or OWF (Ohio Works First) funds will receive a letter indicating the student's free meal status within their student packet.

3) All other students in Akron Middle/High Schools will receive meal program information, including a 2011-2012 family meal application with instructions, in their student packet. A completed meal application should be returned to the school cafeteria for consideration of "Free" or "Reduced-price" meal status. The 2011-2012 prices for lunch meals are:

Middle-High School Student Lunch - \$2.25 Adult Lunch - \$2.75
NIHF-STEM & Miller/South Student Lunch - \$2.25 Adult Lunch - \$2.75
Early College High School Student Lunch - \$2.50
Qualifying Reduced-Price Student Lunch - \$0.40

Breakfast will be offered to all Akron Public School students at no cost.
