Ages 3 to 5

Teen Improv

Intermediate Acting I

Ages 7 to 9

This class is designed for the child who has attended The Introduction to Acting Class and was recommended to continue onto the Intermediate Acting Class, or has equivalent experience on stage. Students will be encouraged to expand on their performance skills to create characters with depth and motivation, work as an ensemble and individually, and use their basic knowledge of theatre vocabulary to interpret the essentials of a scene. Each student will leave the class with new skills and ready to take on their next performance!

Intermediate Acting II

Ages 10 to 17

Saturdays 12:15-1:30 p.m.

This class is designed for the child who has attended The Introduction to Acting Class and was recommended to continue onto the Intermediate Acting II Class, or has equivalent experience on stage. Students will examine different acting techniques and develop a deeper understanding of ways to enhance their skills as an actor. JUMP START Music

Ages 3 to 5
