Miller South School for the Visual and Performing Arts (grades 4–8)

Miller South students take daily classes in their main art interest area as well as receive top academic instruction to prepare them for high school and beyond. Students have many opportunities to perform and show their work throughout the community. Specialties include:

The Akron School for the Arts (grades 9–12)

Located at Firestone High School, the Akron School for the Arts provides students with an integrated arts and classroom curriculum with college prep courses to position them for success after high school. Students have many opportunities to perform and present their work in the community, with many of them going into professional arts careers. Students may specialize in one or more of the following:

- Band
- Choral music
- Dance
- Orchestra
- Theatre
- Visual arts



Audition is required for both programs. Open enrollment typically begins in November and is required for Miller South as well as ASA applicants living outside the Firestone cluster.
