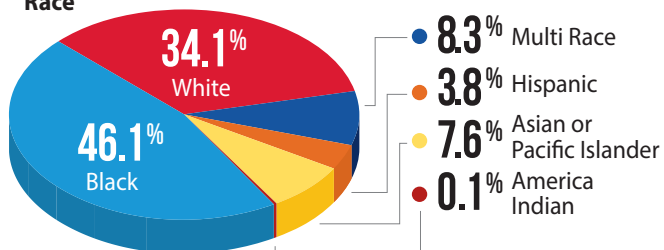

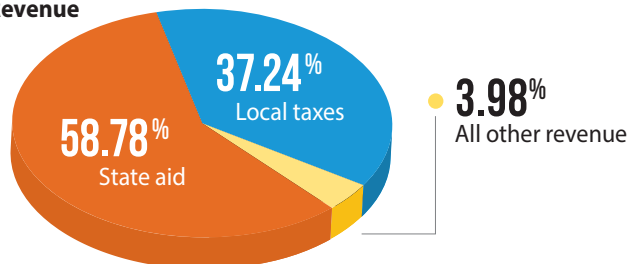

GENERAL FUND SOURCES OF REVENUE

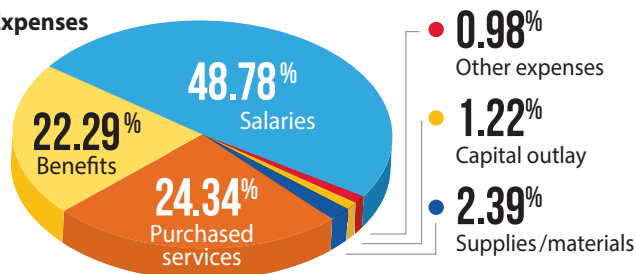

TRANSPORTATION REIMBURSEMENT & MILES

264 VEHICLES transport 4,554 regular, nonpublic, charter and special education students in grades K-9.



Buses: 110 yellow buses transport students to 56 schools with additional use of METRO buses/ passes. Buses travel 1,112,040 miles per year.
